

Website Working Guide – Head Control

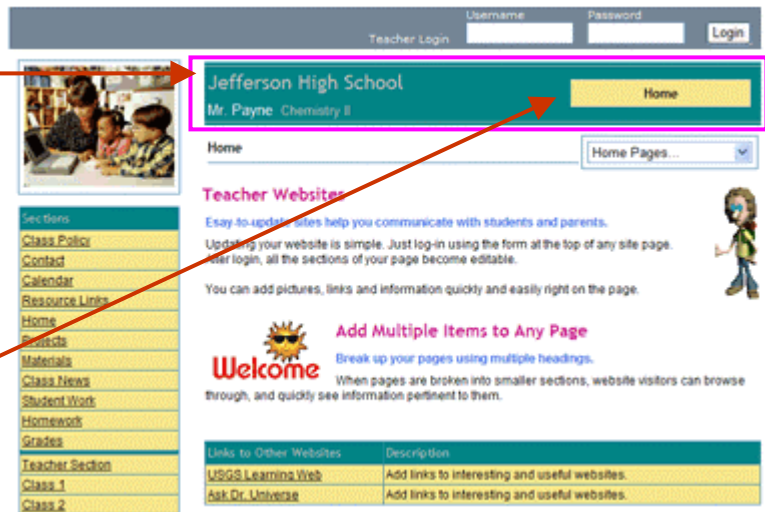
Head Control

The Head Control is shown at the top of every page.

You can use this to specify information that identifies your website, such as your name, school and class or subject.

You will only need to set this once because the information shown remains the same for each page.

This control also automatically shows you, and your visitors, which section of your website you are currently viewing.



Head Control Editing

This is a view of the control in **Edit Mode**.

There are 3 fields provided.

The default values are taken from the information you provided when signing up for a website – School, Your Name and Class.

You can change the information to show whatever you'd like.
